

Why Volunteer?

Volunteers are a significant component of NHSSV's neighborhood improvement projects. Community Volunteer projects attract between two and three hundred individuals annually from all walks of life, including university students, neighborhood leaders, residents, local city representatives and business leaders. The process of volunteering, while providing enormous personal satisfaction, helps to bring the community together and fosters pride in the individual neighborhoods, in addition to helping to increase the stability of the neighborhood.

What Can I Volunteer For?

Volunteer Opportunities 2006

- **Paint-a-Thon neighborhood improvement projects** -- help a low-income community paint homes of senior and low-income homeowners (for corporate and faith-based teams and individuals)
- **Emergentes Community Education Program** -- help us get the word out about this new program designed to educate residents about housing maintenance, housing safety and community involvement.
- **College Interns** - Help us at our Corporate offices during business hours to create new ways to tell the community about our services, outreach at special events and establish new partnerships.

Paint-a-Thon Neighborhood Improvement Projects --

VOLUNTEERS -- both skilled or unskilled, are welcome to help prep or paint a home for our tri-annual Paint-a-Thons.

HOUSE CAPTAINS -- lead a team of 6-10 volunteers at one home. They ensure that all painting and repairs are done accurately and according to schedule.

TEAM LEADER -- leads the planning team and coordinates with House Captains to correct delayed activities, wrap up activities, and thank the volunteers.

BOOTH COORDINATOR -- registers volunteers the day of the event and directs them to the project site. (Corporate, Faith-based or University group)

MATERIALS COORDINATOR -- insures that paint supplies, tools, and materials are in a handy location the day of the event, and collects them at the end of the day.

MEDIA COORDINATOR -- coordinates media to video and document the event.

FOOD COORDINATOR -- coordinates the donations of food and drinks as breakfast and lunch for the volunteers.

VOLUNTEER COORDINATOR -- invites, recruits, and secures volunteers to participate in the event. Also coordinates restroom supplies and clean up activities with the House Captain.
